Máquina de Chicles

(Gum Ball Machine)
This game is a number bingo in disguise!

Materials:

scissors

crayons, color pencils or markers

To make this game:

- 1. Photocopy the gum ball machines in card stock. (One for every player.)
- 2. Photocopy Chicles 1 once. Copy Chicles 2 for every player. Cut all of them out. Place every copy of Chicles 2 in an individual bag. Add 2 numbers from Chicles 1 into each individual bag.
- 3. Photocopy Chicles 3 twice. Cut out one copy and place them in a bag. These gums will be used to call out. The other copy will be the gum keeper, to keep track of what gums you have called out.

To play:

- 1. Give every student a gum machine copy and an individual bag.
- 2. Explain to them that they'll be playing a version of bingo, where you will call out numbers, and they must glue the gum ball into their machine.
- 3. If you have time you can ask them to color the gums and the machine before the game.

Tips:

- Included is a worksheet where students can write out some of the numbers in their gum machine in Spanish, as an extra practice.
